

### ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

between

# HATYAI UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

and

# YUNNAN COLLEGE OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND FOREIGN LANGUAGES, THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA



Hatyai University, Thailand, (hereinafter referred to as "HU") and Yunnan College of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Languages, the People's Republic of China (hereinafter referred to as "YCFAFL") have established a formal understanding and reached the following agreement through the friendly talk on 28 October 2016. This agreement is made and entered into on this seventh day of November 2016 by and between HU and YCFAFL.

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this agreement is to build on relationship from a friendly talk taken place between HU and YCFAFL to establish academic and student admission collaborations between the two parties.

#### **GOALS**

- 1. Promote available Thai programs of HU to Chinese students;
- 2. Implement academic programs and collaborations to achieve mutual benefits of HU and YCFAFL;
- 3. Adhere to the highest academic quality, values, and ethical standards in joint activities.

### Hatyai University agrees to:

1. Facilitate Chinese student involvement in campus culture and immersion into the **HU** curriculum.

## Yunnan College of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Languages agrees to:

- 1. Send students of the following number at the following fees to **HU** for the upgrading of their academic achievements (Bachelor Degrees):
  - No more than forty (≤40) students at THB 48,000 per year per student; or More than forty (>40) students at THB 45,000 per year per student; or More than fifty (>50) students at THB 43,500 per year per student.
  - The above said sum will cover in-classroom study, and field trips. It will not cover boarding expenses, air travel cost, visa application fees, utility fees and insurance;
- 2. Meet the criteria for participation in the **HU** by recruiting Chinese students from any service provinces;
- 3. Provide **HU** with the names of those students who have allowed sharing of their information and are expected to complete program so that **HU** can contact them and extend to them priority consideration for admission;
- 4. Provide students with information about **HU** requirements, so that those students can consider the advantages of selecting classes with the objective of transfer to the **HU**; and
- 5. Designate the program director, coordinator, or counselor as the primary contact for liaison with HU.



# **Teachers' Short Term Program:**

1. **HU** and **YCFAFL** will send its teachers to the other party for short term teaching and training on the languages and culture. The salaries for the chosen teachers are covered by the sending party and the rest are borne by the receiving party.

Anything unmentioned will be discussed based on the principle of mutual benefits and relevant amendments will be documented. Further detailed discussions or agreements will be followed by the presence of the representatives of both parties.
